The City began its rehab assistance program this quarter. It is currently in the bidding, contracting and/or development stages of its demolition, infrastructure, and job training projects.</p> <p>Number of characters entered: 333</p>

<p>The City expended \$2,774 on the publication of an Environmental Notice for its Rehab and Demolition projects. The City expended \$502 on administrative services. The City will provide funds for emergency repairs to ensure the availability of safe housing for low/mod income households in owner occupied structures for major deficiencies, including roof repair and furnace replacement. This quarter, the City encumbered \$100,731 to assist ten (10) low/mod income households. The City also made progress on its demolitions project. It has completed the bid documents for the Request for Proposals and will be advertising for the demolition bid for approximately \$525,000 for 35-45 units within the next two weeks. Street improvements will be started in the Spring, as soon as weather permits. The City plans to complete street improvements on approx. 16 streets throughout the City. A Jobs Training Program will assist low to moderate income persons with employment training in the construction trades industry. The City is currently in the process of developing a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the training.</p> <p>Number of characters entered: 1122</p>
