Quarterly Activities/Project Description*		
<p>Quarterly activities for emergency funds assistance funded on IDIS include: 20 single family rehabs totaling \$220,000 and 20 multi family rehabs totaling \$303,634 for emergency repairs to low income households in owner occupied structures for major deficiencies, including roof repair and furnace replacement. The City has drawn down \$170,835 for single rehabs and \$142,091 for multi rehabs. Demolitions work is underway. A total of \$525,000 has been funded in IDIS and \$134,187 has been drawn down for demolitions. We are currently processing a \$61,083 invoice to be drawn next week. We are expecting another voucher to come in for approx. \$294,000 within two weeks. \$916,906 was drawn down for street improvements. The street improvement contract is 91% complete. Construction Work for sidewalk improvements is in process with the majority of the work completed. Our sidewalk contractors are in process of submitting \$250,000 invoice voucher. Some minor delays were due to coordination issues with National Grid (buried electric lines). The City selected the Buffalo Urban League to conduct its job training program and is currently in the process of contract execution. There was a slight delay due to having to rebid a portion of the construction training subcontract. The Buffalo Urban League has put together a timeline and revised budget. The projected start date is currently bidding out the</p>
