Title of Position: Traffic Signal Specialist

Duties: Troubleshoots solid state and electrical mechanical traffic signal equipment; removes causes of grounds, opens and shorts; repairs malfunctioning traffic signal controllers. Installs traffic signals and signal controllers. Strings messenger and makes necessary wire and cable connections between signal heads and controllers; repairs, removes and replaces defective wiring and signal transmission lines. Erects, installs and maintains support poles, manholes, overhead and underground wiring used in traffic signal systems. Performs work involving trenching and installation of underground ducts, splicing of cables and climbing poles. Maintains records concerning work in progress and completed work. Drives to and from work sites. Performs related work as required.

Minimum Qualifications:

PROMOTIONAL: Continuous and permanent status as in any city department as an ELECTRICIAN for one year.

In addition, applicants must have **one year** of full-time experience in the maintenance and/or repair of electrical or solid state equipment.


OPEN COMPETITIVE:
